Paraskevas Anastasiou was born in 1971 in Sotira Famagusta. He graduated from Paralimni High school and after his military service he graduated in 1995 from the London Southbank University with BA (HON's) in Accounting and Finance. He successfully completed the professional exams of the chartered Association of Certified Accountants (ACCA/Affiliate).

Since 1997, he works for the Cyprus Employers and Industrialists Federation (OEB) until 2012 as an Officer at the Industry Development Department, then (2002-2009) as an officer of the Industry and Services Department and from 2009 until 2013 as an officer in the Management Development Department. In January 2013 was promoted as Head of the newly established Energy Policy Department (in 2016 the department changed to "Energy & Environment Services"). As from September 2016 is the Head of the International Entrepreneurship Affairs and Events Management Services.
