Giorgos Petrou was born in Engomi- Nicosia in the year 1947. He studied Mechanical Engineering at the University of Surrey in England with specialisation in Economics and Industrial Law. On return to Cyprus in 1972 was employed by SHELL and following extensive training overseas on Fuel production and Lubricants, was appointed Sales Engineer for Cyprus. He served in various positions of "SHELL" and "BP" both in Cyprus and at the headquarters of the Companies in Athens and London and in 1995 was promoted to the position of President and CEO of "BP Cyprus" where he served until 2002. In 2003, he was appointed as Non-Executive Chairman

of the newly created BP Eastern Mediterranean.

He is President and Founding member of the Alzheimer's Friendship Foundation, which aims to create day-care centres for people suffering from the Alzheimer's decease.
