Andria Laou was born in August 1986 in Limassol where she grew up. After completing her studies at the Department of Greek Literature at the University of Patras, she pursued her postgraduate studies at King's College London in the United Kingdom. Upon her return to Cyprus in September 2009, she has worked in various positions requiring administrative, organizational, character integrity, decision making and time management skills.

At first, she worked in one of Limassol's largest private institutes as a consultant for high school students who wanted to study abroad. A year later - and after receiving a full-time scholarship to pursue a second postgraduate degree in Business Administration (MBA) -, she accepted a job offer to work at one of the largest private tertiary education institutions in Cyprus, initially as an admissions officer in Nicosia and continuing as head of the ACCA Department of Professional Studies in Limassol.
