## NOTE FOR THE FILE

Subject: AD674 – anti-dumping investigation into imports of steel wind towers originating in the People's Republic of China

Non-imposition of provisional measures

On 21 October 2020, the European Commission ('the Commission') initiated an antidumping investigation concerning the imports of steel wind towers originating in the People's Republic of China<sup>1</sup> on the basis of Article 5 of Regulation (EU) 2016/1036 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2016 on protection against dumped imports from countries not members of the European Union<sup>2</sup> ('the basic Regulation').

Given the technical complexity of the case, the Commission has decided to continue the anti-dumping investigation and to not impose provisional measures at this stage.

This note therefore constitutes the notification to interested parties required under Article 19a(2) of the basic Regulation.
