Πτυχίο Νομικής

Το πρόγραμμα νομικής του Πανεπιστημίου Λεμεσού παρέχει στους φοιτητές πλήρη, σύγχρονη και πολύπλευρη γνώση και εκπαίδευση στο πεδίο της νομικής επιστήμης, παρέχοντας όλα τα αναγκαία εφόδια για τους μελλοντικούς νομικούς για επαγγελματική και ακαδημαϊκή καριέρα. Το πρόγραμμα προσφέρει τις θεμελιακές γνώσεις που αφορούν τη νομική επιστήμη με επίκεντρο στο κυπριακό και το ελληνικό δίκαιο καθώς και επί σύγχρονων ζητημάτων του δικαίου σε συνάρτηση με συναφή επιστημονικά, επαγγελματικά και γνωστικά αντικείμενα, εφόδια τα οποία παρέχουν στο απόφοιτο του προγράμματος τη δυνατότητα να ανταποκριθεί σε επαγγελματικές προκλήσεις τόσο σε τοπικό επίπεδο όσο και στον διεθνή χώρο. Επίσης, το πρόγραμμα νομικής του Πανεπιστημίου Λεμεσού, σε συνδυασμό με τις συνεργασίες του με επαγγελματικούς φορείς όπως με τον Παγκύπριο Δικηγορικό Σύλλογο, χαρακτηρίζεται από καινοτόμα στοιχεία και σύγχρονα μαθήματα όπου παρέχουν στους απόφοιτους ευρείες επιλογές στην αγορά εργασίας. Πτυχίο στην Προδημοτική Εκπαίδευση

Σκοπός του προγράμματος Προδημοτικής Εκπαίδευσης είναι να προσφέρει στους φοιτητές μια ολοκληρωμένη, σύγχρονη και πολυδιάστατη γνώση στον τομέα της προδημοτικής αγωγής και εκπαίδευσης. Το πρόγραμμα έχει σχεδιαστεί για να εξοπλίζει τους μελλοντικούς εκπαιδευτικούς με τα απαραίτητα θεωρητικά και πρακτικά εφόδια για τη διδασκαλία και μάθηση των παιδιών προσχολικής ηλικίας (3-6 χρονών) και την προαγωγή της ολόπλευρης ανάπτυξής τους, τόσο σε γνωστικό όσο και σε κοινωνικό-συναισθηματικό επίπεδο. Μέσω του προγράμματος, οι φοιτητές θα αποκτήσουν βασικές παιδαγωγικές και διδακτικές γνώσεις, θα κατανοήσουν τους τομείς ανάπτυξης του παιδιού, και θα εξειδικευτούν στις κατάλληλες μορφές οργάνωσης της μάθησης για τις ηλικιακές ομάδες παιδιών προσχολικής ηλικίας.

Επιπλέον, το πρόγραμμα ενσωματώνει τις σύγχρονες κοινωνικές και παιδαγωγικές τάσεις και κοινωνικοπολιτισμικές αλλαγές στο πλαίσιο της Κύπρου και της Ελλάδας, όπως η αξιοποίηση της τεχνολογίας στην εκπαίδευση, ο πολιτισμικός πλουραλισμός, η διαφοροποίηση της μάθησης και η περιβαλλοντική εκπαίδευση. Το πρόγραμμα συνδυάζει θεωρητικές γνώσεις με πρακτική άσκηση, δίνοντας έμφαση στην άμεση επαφή των φοιτητών με το σχολικό περιβάλλον μέσω συστηματικής σχολικής εμπειρίας. Παράλληλα, οι φοιτητές έχουν τη δυνατότητα να διαμορφώσουν ευέλικτα το πρόγραμμα σπουδών τους και να επιλέξουν εξειδικευμένα θέματα, όπως η διδασκαλία της ελληνικής ως δεύτερης γλώσσας, οι ειδικές αναπτυξιακές διαταραχές και παρεμβάσεις, η διαφοροποιημένη παιδαγωγική, και η γνωστική και συναισθηματική νευροεπιστήμη.

Πτυχίο Ψυχολογίας- Εξ Αποστάσεως

Το Πτυχίο Ψυχολογίας προσφέρει μια ολοκληρωμένη εκπαίδευση στον τομέα της ψυχολογίας, συνδυάζοντας τη βασική θεωρητική γνώση με την πρακτική εφαρμογή, ώστε να εξασφαλίζεται μια σφαιρική ακαδημαϊκή εμπειρία.

Στο επίκεντρο του προγράμματος βρίσκεται η καλλιέργεια ηθικής συνείδησης και υπεύθυνης συμπεριφοράς στους φοιτητές. Είτε ασχολούνται με την ψυχολογική έρευνα είτε με την επαγγελματική πρακτική, οι φοιτητές καθοδηγούνται προς την ηθική συμπεριφορά, ενισχύοντας την ακεραιότητα και τον σεβασμό σε όλες τις αλληλεπιδράσεις με άτομα και ομάδες.

Προοπτικές Καριέρας

Οι απόφοιτοι του Πτυχίου στην Ψυχολογία μπορούν να προσδοκούν ισχυρές επαγγελματικές προοπτικές, καθώς τα δεδομένα της Στατιστικής Υπηρεσίας Κύπρου (CYSTAT) και της Ευρωπαϊκής Επιτροπής αναδεικνύουν σταθερά τα υψηλά ποσοστά απασχολησιμότητας των αποφοίτων ψυχολογίας στην Κύπρο και σε όλη την Ευρώπη. Το πρόγραμμα εξοπλίζει τους φοιτητές με ένα ευρύ και ευέλικτο σύνολο δεξιοτήτων μέσα από ισχυρή ακαδημαϊκή βάση, εκπαίδευση στην έρευνα και πρακτική εμπειρία μέσω ευκαιριών παρατήρησης σε πραγματικά εργασιακά περιβάλλοντα.

Οι φοιτητές έχουν τη δυνατότητα να επιλέξουν μία από δύο εξειδικεύσεις –Κλινική και Συμβουλευτική Ψυχολογία ή Γνωστική και Συμπεριφορική Νευροεπιστήμη. Οι εξειδικεύσεις αυτές δεν είναι υποχρεωτικές και αποσκοπούν στο να βοηθήσουν τους φοιτητές να αναστοχαστούν τα ενδιαφέροντά τους και να διαμορφώσουν πιθανές επαγγελματικές πορείες από τα πρώτα στάδια των σπουδών τους.

Εναλλακτικά, οι φοιτητές μπορούν να ακολουθήσουν τη γενική διαδρομή χωρίς επιλογή εξειδίκευσης, διατηρώντας έτσι ευελιξία στην ακαδημαϊκή και επαγγελματική τους ανάπτυξη.

Αν και απαιτείται περαιτέρω μεταπτυχιακή εκπαίδευση για την επαγγελματική άσκηση σε τομείς όπως η κλινική ή η σχολική ψυχολογία, το πρόγραμμα προετοιμάζει τους αποφοίτους για ένα ευρύ φάσμα επαγγελματικών ευκαιριών, όπως:

- Ερευνητικούς και ακαδημαϊκούς ρόλους (διδασκαλικές σπουδές, διδασκαλία)
- Υποστηρικτικούς ρόλους στην εφαρμοσμένη ψυχολογία

- Εργασία στον δημόσιο τομέα και σε μη κερδοσκοπικούς οργανισμούς με επίκεντρο την ψυχική υγεία και την ευημερία.

Το αυξανόμενο ενδιαφέρον για την ψυχολογία στην Κύπρο, που αποτυπώνεται στην αύξηση των εγγραφών φοιτητών, υποδεικνύει την αυξανόμενη ζήτηση για αποφοίτους ψυχολογίας σε διάφορους τομείς. ΜEd Ειδική Αγωγή και Νέες Τεχνολογίες

Το μεταπτυχιακό Ειδική Αγωγή και Νέες Τεχνολογίες είναι ένα διαπανεπιστημιακό πρόγραμμα που προσφέρεται κοινού από το Πανεπιστήμιο Λεμεσού (Τμήμα Επιστημών της Αγωγής) και το Πανεπιστήμιο Δυτικής Αττικής (Τμήμα Βιοϊατρικών Επιστημών). Σκοπός του κοινού μεταπτυχιακού είναι να εισαγάγει τους/τις φοιτητές/τριες σε καινοτόμες μεθόδους διδασκαλίας και πρακτικές ενσωμάτωσης εκπαιδευτικών τεχνολογικών μέσων/εργαλείων/εφαρμογών και τους εφοδιάζει με την ικανότητα να προσαρμόζουν τη διδασκαλία τους σε μαθητές με αναπηρία και ειδικές εκπαιδευτικές ανάγκες. Οι εκπαιδευτικοί μαθαίνουν πώς να αξιολογούν τις φυσικές και μαθησιακές ανάγκες των μαθητών τους, να εφαρμόζουν εξατομικευμένες παρεμβάσεις και να αξιοποιούν εμπειριστατωμένες πρακτικές σε αυθεντικά περιβάλλοντα μάθησης. Το πρόγραμμα δίνει έμφαση στη δημιουργία αποτελεσματικών περιβαλλόντων μάθησης και στις τεχνικές διαχείρισης της τάξης για την αντιμετώπιση ποικίλων προκλήσεων, συμπεριλαμβανομένου των διανοητικών, συναισθηματικών και μαθησιακών δυσκολιών.

Προσδοκώμενα αποτελέσματα:

- Ανάπτυξη κατανόησης Μαθησιακών Δυσκολιών: Να εφοδιάσει τους/τις φοιτητές/τριες με γνώσεις και εμπειρία στον τομέα της Ειδικής Εκπαίδευσης και στην Παιδαγωγική της ένταξης και συμπερίληψης, συμπεριλαμβανομένου των διαφορετικών τύπων αναπηρίας (π.χ. γνωστικών, σωματικών, αισθητηριακών) και ειδικών εκπαιδευτικών αναγκών (π.χ. ΔΕΠΥ, Δυσλεξία, Δυσαριθμσία) και πώς αυτές επηρεάζουν τη μαθησιακή διαδικασία.
- Προώθηση αρχών Συμπεριληπτικής Μάθησης: Να βοηθήσει τους/τις φοιτητές/τριες να κατανοήσουν τις έννοιες συμπερίληψη και ισότητα και πώς μπορούν να εφαρμοστούν στη μαθησιακή διαδικασία και στο σχολικό πλαίσιο.
- Εφαρμογή Καινοτόμων Μεθόδων Διδασκαλίας: Να διδάξει τους/τις φοιτητές/τριες πώς να εφαρμόζουν καινοτόμες μεθόδους διδασκαλίας και στρατηγικές σε αυθεντικά εκπαιδευτικά περιβάλλοντα για την υποστήριξη των μαθητών με αναπηρία και ειδικές μαθησιακές ανάγκες.
- Δεξιότητες χρήσης Νέων Τεχνολογιών: Να διδάξει τους/τις φοιτητές/τριες πώς να αξιοποιούν και να αξιολογούν υποστηρικτικά και εκπαιδευτικά τεχνολογικά μέσα και εργαλεία που να διευκολύνουν τη μάθηση μαθητών/τριών με αναπηρία και ειδικών εκπαιδευτικών αναγκών.
- Αποτελεσματική Αξιολόγηση και Παρέμβαση: Να εκπαιδεύσει τους/τις φοιτητές/τριες στην αξιολόγηση και εκτίμηση των μαθησιακών αναγκών των μαθητών/τριών και στον σχεδιασμό και στην υλοποίηση αποτελεσματικών παρεμβάσεων για την υποστήριξη της εκπαιδευτικής και συναισθηματικής τους ευημερίας.

- Δεξιότητες Έρευνας: Να αναπτύξει δεξιότητες έρευνας που επιτρέπουν στους/στις φοιτητές/τριες να αξιολογούν κριτικά υπάρχουσες έρευνες στην Ειδική Αγωγή και στις Νέες Τεχνολογίες και να διεξάγουν δικές τους ερευνητικές μελέτες για τη μεγιστοποίηση των μαθησιακών αποτελεσμάτων.

Προοπτικές καριέρας

Οι απόφοιτοι του μεταπτυχιακού προγράμματος σπουδών στην Ειδική Αγωγή και Νέες Τεχνολογίες θα έχουν πλούσιες προοπτικές απασχόλησης στο δημόσιο και ιδιωτικό τομέα. Οι δεξιότητες που θα αποκτήσουν μέσω του συγκεκριμένου προγράμματος θα μπορούν να εφαρμοστούν σε διαφορετικά πλαίσια και τομείς εκπαίδευσης. Οι απόφοιτοι θα μπορούν να εργαστούν ως ειδικοί δάσκαλοι στην δημόσια και ιδιωτική εκπαίδευση ή σε κέντρα υποστήριξης παιδιών με αναπηρία ή/και άλλες ειδικές εκπαιδευτικές ανάγκες. Επιπλέον, θα μπορούν να δράσουν ως σύμβουλοι και καθοδηγητές, να εργοδοτηθούν ως ερευνητές στον τομέα της Ειδικής Αγωγής μέσω νέων τεχνολογιών ή να επιδιώξουν επιπλέον μεταπτυχιακές ή διδακτορικές σπουδές.

BSc in Psychology - Face to face or Distance Learning

The BSc in Psychology offers a comprehensive education in the diverse field of psychology, blending core theoretical knowledge with practical application to ensure a well-rounded academic experience.

Central to the program's mission is the cultivation of ethical awareness and responsible conduct among students. Whether engaged in psychological research or professional practice, students are guided towards ethical behaviour, fostering integrity and respect in all interactions with individuals and groups.

Career Impact

Graduates of the BSc in Psychology program can look forward to strong employment prospects, with data from CYSTAT and the European Commission consistently highlighting high employability rates for psychology graduates in Cyprus and across Europe. The program equips students with a broad and adaptable skill set through a solid academic foundation, research training, and practical experience gained via shadowing opportunities in real-world settings.

Students have the option to explore one of two concentrations—Clinical and Counseling Psychology or Cognitive and Behavioral Neuroscience. These are not mandatory and serve to help students reflect on their interests and clarify possible career paths early in their studies. Alternatively, students may choose to follow the general route without selecting a concentration, maintaining flexibility in their academic and professional development.

While further postgraduate training is required for professional practice in areas such as clinical or school psychology, the program prepares graduates for a wide range of career opportunities, including:

- Research and academic roles (PhD studies, teaching)
- Assistant roles in applied psychology
- Human resources and organizational consulting
- Educational and youth services
- Public sector and nonprofit work focused on mental health and wellbeing.

The growing interest in psychology in Cyprus, reflected in rising student enrollment, points to an expanding demand for psychology graduates across various sectors. With their diverse training and early exposure to the field, graduates are well-positioned to pursue further education or transition confidently into the workforce.

Μεταπτυχιακό στη Σχολική Ψυχολογία - Εξ Αποστάσεως

Σκοπός του Μεταπτυχιακού στη Σχολική Ψυχολογία μέσω εξ' αποστάσεως εκπαίδευσης είναι να εκπαιδεύσει και να καταρτίσει ειδικούς στη Σχολική Ψυχολογία, σύμφωνα με τις τρέχουσες διεθνείς τάσεις και πρακτικές, οι οποίοι θα εργάζονται με παιδιά, οικογένειες και εκπαιδευτικούς στο πλαίσιο του σχολείου. Οι απόφοιτοι θα είναι σε θέση να εφαρμόζουν επικυρωμένες πρακτικές προκειμένου να προσφέρουν ψυχολογικές υπηρεσίες, εφαρμόζοντας τις γνώσεις τους στην ψυχολογική θεωρία, υψηλά επίπεδα ακεραιότητας (ηθικής και νομικής) και σεβόμενοι τους Νόμους και Κανονισμούς της Κύπρου και της Ευρωπαϊκής Ένωσης.

Το πρόγραμμα βασίζεται στα πρότυπα της του International School Psychology Association (ISPA) και προετοιμάζει τους φοιτητές για μια καριέρα σχολικού ψυχολόγου όσον αφορά στην ανάπτυξη βασικών γνώσεων στην ψυχολογία και την εκπαίδευση, στη διεξαγωγή διαγνωστικής αξιολόγησης των μαθητών, στην παροχή ψυχολογικής συμβουλευτικής σε όλα τα μέλη της σχολικής κοινότητας, στη διαχείριση κρίσεων στο πλαίσιο του σχολείου, στην ανάπτυξη και εφαρμογή προγραμμάτων πρόληψης και παρέμβασης, στο να είναι σε θέση να εργάζονται σε πολυπολιτισμικά περιβάλλοντα, στην ανάπτυξη των ερευνητικών μεθόδων, των επαγγελματικών και διαπροσωπικών δεξιοτήτων τους.

Για εισδοχή στο πρόγραμμα απαιτείται πτυχίο Ψυχολογίας. Το πρόγραμμα απαιτεί την εκπόνηση ερευνητικής μελέτης και 1000 ώρες πρακτικής άσκησης σε σχολεία και δομές στην Κύπρο.

Προοπτικές καριέρας

Το πρόγραμμα βασίζεται στα πρότυπα του International School Psychology Association (ISPA) και πληροί τις απαιτήσεις του Συμβουλίου Εγγραφής Ψυχολόγων Κύπρου για την εγγραφή των αποφοίτων ως Σχολικοί Ψυχολόγοι. Το πρόγραμμα προετοιμάζει τους φοιτητές για μια καριέρα σχολικού ψυχολόγου. Οι απόφοιτοι, μεταξύ άλλων, θα μπορούν να εργαστούν σε κυβερνητικές υπηρεσίες, σε ιδιωτικά σχολεία, Μη Κυβερνητικές Οργανώσεις, ή/και να ιδιωτεύσουν ως σχολικοί ψυχολόγοι.

MSc in Occupational and Organisational Psychology

The MSc in Occupational and Organisational Psychology (Distance Learning) helps students understand human behaviour at work and the functioning of organisations. The programme combines psychological theory with practical learning in areas such as motivation, psychological assessment at work, leadership and engagement, and health and well-being. Students also have the option to undertake a 1000-hour practicum, which provides hands-on experience and enables them to apply for registration as licensed psychologists with the Cyprus Council of Registered Professional Psychologists.

Career Impact

Graduates of the MSc in Occupational and Organisational Psychology are equipped to work in roles such as organisational consultants, HR specialists, behavioural analysts, and employee well-being advisors. Those who complete the practicum route meet the criteria for registration as licensed psychologists in Cyprus. Others may pursue careers in human resource management, as well as learning and development. This MSc Programme also provides a solid foundation for doctoral study or research careers in universities, consultancy firms, and public or private research organisations.

Admission Criteria

Undergraduate Admission

1. High school leaving certificate:
 - 15/20 (for Cyprus public schools) or 80/100 (for private schools)
 - Three GSE A Level with grades ABB or an International Baccalaureate with a minimum of 32 points.
2. Satisfactory Personal Statement on application
3. English Language Proficiency* IETLS 5.0 (B1-B2 intermediate level) and above or equivalent as per the *table below or graduation from English-language high-school.

Graduate Admission

1. Bachelor's degree from an accredited program. In terms of GPA, we expect 2:2 and above from UK schools, 3.0 and above from US schools, and 6.5 and above from Cypriot and Greek schools. Candidates with a lower grade than the above, may be admitted if they have compensatory strengths in terms of work experience or other accomplishments (for example, CFA, ACCA, or ACA).
2. Two reference letters
3. English Language Proficiency* IETLS 5.0 (B1-B2 intermediate level) and above or equivalent as per the *table below or graduation from a previous fully taught in English language degree.

Nationals of non-EU countries*

For both undergraduate and graduate programs taught in English a “Very Good Knowledge” of English is required at upper level B1 of the Council of Europe's Common European Framework of Reference, evidenced by an upper level B1 score or higher in one of the approved by the Council of Ministers International English Language Tests listed in the table.

**Nationals of Australia, Ireland, New Zealand, UK, USA, and Canada (for Canada only graduates of institutions with English instruction).*

Nationals of the above listed countries, whose native language is English, do not need to present a certificate of success in international examinations, or take the placement test.

EU nationals

The adequacy of English language proficiency of EU nationals for attending undergraduate and graduate programs at UoL is established through the UoL placement test. Candidates with English language deficiencies can start their studies while strengthening their knowledge of the language for academic purposes by taking the UoL Remedial English course (ESL2 and/or ESL3, depending on their placement test score).

Foundation Course for Learning English Language

The UoL English Language Foundation Course prepares non-EU international students with lower-level B1 language skills (e.g., IELTS 4.0) to reach upper-level B1 or higher (e.g., IELTS 5.0). It focuses on listening, speaking, reading, writing, academic, and communication skills. Offered onsite and online for one academic year, students must pass an approved exam. Failure in Cyprus means no repeat, and candidates who don't meet requirements should apply for the course.

Additional Admission Requirements

The MSc in Business Intelligence and Data Analytics require satisfactory quantitative skills as evidenced by the subject and courses taken during Bachelor degree study. The major can be in science, engineering, economics, management, biomedical sciences, and even law and business.

Degrees and Transcripts

All applicants are required to submit certified copies of their High School Leaving Certificate (“Apolytirion” for local applicants), Bachelor's Degree and Transcripts (for all years of study). If the certificates/degrees and grades/marks are not issued in Greek or English, a certified translation will be required.

Programs Taught in Greek

The program MSc in Educational Leadership and Management is focused solely on Cyprus and Greece and is taught in Greek language. Students on this program are not required to meet the English Language Proficiency requirements.

Payment Policy

1. Invoices are issued at the beginning of the month in accordance to the invoice dates and are due by the end of the month.
2. Upon registration, students must pay the registration fee and the first instalment in full.
3. Registration and application fees are not refundable.
4. Subscription fees where applicable are equally apportioned over the invoices issued as per invoice dates.
5. Fees are not refunded after the payment has been completed unless a notice of withdrawal has been formally given in writing before the invoice date. For example, if the first invoice is to be paid by 30/09 then as of 1/10 of the same year these tuition fees are not refundable. See 'Refund policy'.
6. If students decide to terminate their studies, they must inform the school in writing of their decision before their next invoice date. Otherwise, the invoice for that period is payable and non-refundable. See Refund Policy.
7. Scholarships and other fee waivers for all conventional programs are excluded from the first invoice and equally distributed over the remaining invoices. For Distance Learning and online programs are equally apportioned over all invoices including the first one.
8. Low grades or failure to complete the programme, will result to the withdrawal of any scholarship awarded, as per UoL rules and regulations. In this case, students are obligated to pay their instalments or credits attended at the full rate provided the students give us advance notice for withdrawal. Students with scholarships will pay the first instalment in full. Students who drop out of the program and are on scholarship, their scholarship will be withdrawn, and they will be required to reimburse UoL.
9. Students that fail to settle their accounts as per the approved UoL payment schedule, will not be permitted to attend classes or use any other UoL facilities, including access to the student Intranet and Moodle. This will be strictly enforced by the University.
10. Students from abroad of all conventional programs should pay their fees in advance via a single instalment.

Refund Policy

At the University of Limassol (UoL), we understand that circumstances may arise that necessitate a refund of tuition fees or other charges. Below, we outline our refund policy to provide clarity and fairness in such situations:

Termination, Withdrawal, and Dismissal

Our refund policy applies in cases of study termination, withdrawal, and dismissal, with the following distinctions:

In cases of dismissal due to a violation of the law and/or commission of a disciplinary offense, any amount paid is non-refundable, and the student remains liable for any pending payments.

Withdrawal/Dismissal and Notice Requirements

In case of withdrawal, students must provide written notice to UoL. The date of receipt of the written notice by UoL is considered the withdrawal date. It is the responsibility of the student to complete the withdrawal procedure.

In case of dismissal, UoL will send written notice to the student. The date of UoL's notice is the dismissal date.

Non-Refundable Fees

Registration fees and all other fees and/or amounts included in the first invoice (e.g., tuition fees, subscription fees) are non-refundable under any circumstances.

Tuition Fee Refund Schedule

For tuition fees included in subsequent invoices, refunds are determined based on the time of withdrawal or dismissal within four weeks of invoice issuance, as follows:

- Withdrawal or dismissal during the 1st week from invoice issuance: 100% tuition fee refund, 0% tuition fee charge.
- Withdrawal or dismissal during the 2nd week: 75% tuition fee refund, 25% tuition fee charge.
- Withdrawal or dismissal during the 3rd week: 50% tuition fee refund, 50% tuition fee charge.
- Withdrawal or dismissal during the 4th week: 25% tuition fee refund, 75% tuition fee charge.
- Withdrawal or dismissal after the 4th week: 0% tuition fee refund, 100% tuition fee charge.

Scholarship Recipients

For students who have received scholarships from UoL:

- In case of dismissal due to a violation of the law and/or disciplinary offense, the student is liable to pay back the corresponding scholarship amount.
- In cases of withdrawal or dismissal for reasons other than law violations or disciplinary offenses UoL retains discretion to decide whether the student must repay all or part of the scholarship amount.

International/Non - EU Students for International/Non - EU students

If an approved immigration visa application is not utilized or is rejected due to student-related reasons (e.g., incomplete, or false documentation), a non-refundable fee of €500 applies.

Outstanding Fees and Obligations

Upon withdrawal or dismissal, students remain liable for unpaid tuition fees, non-refundable fees, and other obligations. UoL has the right to offset any refund owed against these outstanding amounts.

Return of Property

Students must return any property belonging to UoL or items provided during their studies (e.g., laptops, technical equipment). Failure to do so may result in relevant charges.

Timely Refunds

UoL commits to processing refunds within 30 days from the withdrawal or dismissal date.

Course Registration

Course registration must be completed no later than 30 days before the course start date. Rescheduling or cancellation must occur 30 days before elective courses or 7 days before core courses start. Late registration and cancellation fees may apply, with a 25% discount for early payment (within 7 days from charge notification) of late enrolment fees.

Course Registration and Cancellation Policy

Course Registration Deadline: All students are required to register for courses no later than 30 days before the first day of the course.

Rescheduling and Cancellation: If a student wishes to reschedule or cancel their registration, they must adhere to the following timelines:

For elective courses: Cancellation or rescheduling must be requested at least 30 days prior to the course's start date.

For core courses: Cancellation or rescheduling must be requested at least 7 days prior to the course's start date.

Late Registration and Cancellation Fees: Late course registration and cancellation fees are imposed in accordance with the Payment Policy.

In cases where unforeseen circumstances prevent a student from attending a course, the student must promptly notify the Admin Office Manager with the necessary documentation. The Admin Office Manager will then cancel the student's registration.

Scholarships

Scholarships / Financial Aid / Subsidized Tuition Fees

The University of Limassol awards scholarships based on academic criteria. At the same time, recognizing the difficulties caused by the economic crisis and as part of its corporate social responsibility, the UoL offers subsidized tuition fees to students with financial difficulties.

Scholarships for UoL Graduate students

For students who choose to study in graduate programs, the University of Limassol offers scholarships based on academic criteria and according to the grades obtained during undergraduate studies.

For some graduate programs, scholarships may be awarded based on the student's professional experience in addition to the academic criteria.

Furthermore, the UoL offers students with financial difficulties the opportunity to study with reduced tuition fees (subsidized tuition fees) as part of its corporate social responsibility scheme.

At the UoL Student Welfare Office, we are committed to creating an inclusive and welcoming environment for all students, regardless of background or circumstances. We believe that a supportive community is essential to your success as a student, and we are dedicated to fostering a sense of belonging and connection within our campus community.

Counselling

Our counselling services provide confidential support to students whether they face personal, academic, or emotional difficulties. The Student Welfare Officer is dedicated to assisting students in overcoming difficulties and achieving personal growth.

The counselling services offer individual support, groups, workshops, online guidance, and referrals to other support services, and are free of charge to all registered students (undergraduate or graduate) at the University. Student Welfare Support / Enrolment and Induction

The induction process at UoL, getting to know the university, its culture, its environment, and its people. It begins at the point of enquiry, unfolds gradually up until the official admissions stage, and continues with the student orientation and a series of other “getting to know you” activities. When students join the University of Limassol, they become part of the UoL family, where they can expect to receive personal attention and to enjoy a friendly, supportive, and welcoming environment. Receiving personal attention right from the very beginning makes you feel at home away from home.

Individual and group orientation sessions are provided to all newly registered students (local and international) by our student support officers. We also organize Orientation Days at the beginning of each academic year, the content of which is

available in the student intranet and Moodle page. Orientation Days also present an excellent opportunity for new students to find out about various student activities and participate.

Furthermore, all new students are assigned a personal academic advisor, usually their Program Director, who offers support and guidance throughout their studies at UoL. New students receive support from buddy groups that include other students and alumni, as well as from mentor groups that include faculty, corporate members and academic affiliates of UoL.

Personal development of students

UoL pays particular attention to students’ continuous personal and professional development. Students are assigned advisors, and the Dean and Program Directors have an open-door policy for students. Students are encouraged to consult with their advisor at any time that they may need help.

Such consultations most often take place during initial student entry, helping students to plan their courses, elective tracks and plan of study as well as answering questions about the programme curriculum and schedule.

Disabilities and Long-Term Conditions

The Student Welfare Office is equipped to help you with any adjustments you may need due to a disability or long-term medical condition. We review needs on an individual basis and collaborate with departments around the University to promote inclusion and accessible teaching and evaluation techniques.

If necessary, advise/liase with academic departments to make reasonable adjustments. Adjustments may include more time in tests, smaller exam rooms, different methods of coursework evaluation, and anything else that can be adapted to each person’s needs.

Learning Difficulties

Learning difficulties (LDs) refer to a variety of co-occurring issues that can significantly disrupt academic achievement by affecting information processing and learning.

- Dyslexia
- Dyspraxia or Developmental Coordination Disorder (DCD)
- Dyscalculia
- Dysgraphia
- Attention Deficit Disorder (ADD) or attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD)

As a result, tailored support and reasonable adjustments may be required to guarantee that students with learning disabilities do not suffer academic disadvantages.

The Student Welfare Office will take your unique needs into consideration to provide you with the best possible support. If you do not have a full diagnostic report, we can advise you on



how to obtain it. Please contact the Student Welfare Office if you would like more information about the options available for LD assessments.

Mental health and wellbeing

Students sometimes report they are going through psychological and emotional issues that affect their academic success, personal development and wellbeing. Poor mental health contributes to lack of motivation and problem focusing which can lead to failing grades or even abandoning their studies.

UoL offers in-house support and private counselling for its students upon request. This service can also be in collaboration with external mental health professionals registered in the General Health System, in case of clinical assessment. Students are informed of the emergency numbers they should call in case of a crisis, including the contact number of the Head of UoL Student Welfare Office.

Parenting Support

The University of Limassol recognizes the unique challenges that students who are also parents might face. We offer a variety of support services and adjustments to help students balance their academic responsibilities with their parental duties.

Our services include:

- Counselling services tailored to the needs of student-parents.
- Information on financial aid and resources for student-parents.
- Peer support networks for student-parents to connect with others facing similar challenges.

Sexual Harassment and Violence Support

The University of Limassol is committed to creating a safe and friendly environment for all students. If you have experienced sexual harassment or violence, we provide confidential support services to help you get through this difficult time. Our support includes:

- Access to our counselling services.
- Referrals to medical professionals registered with the General Healthcare System (GESY) for clinical services and examinations.

- Prevention and awareness campaigns to promote a culture of consent and respect on campus.

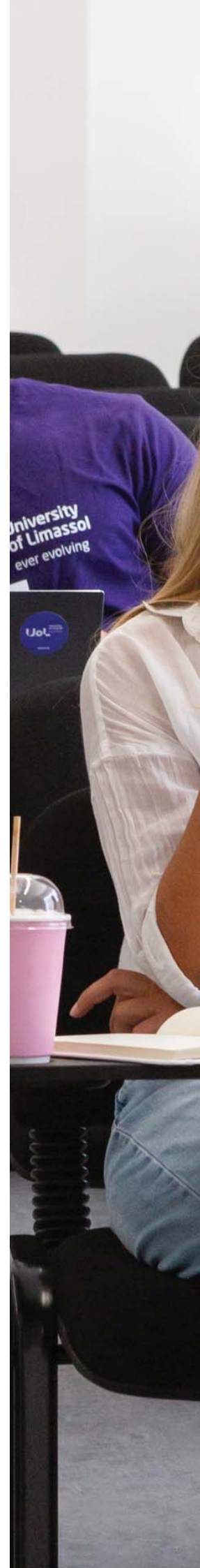
The mission of the UoL Research Centre, is to be providing the following services to the UoL research community and collaborators beyond it:

Library



The UoL Library serves as a valuable resource and information centre for the students, faculty, and researchers associated with the University.

The University of Limassol (UoL) Library is designed to actively support the academic and research activities of the institution. UoL offers a broad and interdisciplinary range of programs in business administration, education, psychology, technology, and social sciences, including postgraduate and doctoral studies. The library is committed to meeting the needs of students and faculty by providing rich and high-quality resources that foster learning, research, and knowledge development.

It maintains a fully updated collection of print and electronic resources aligned with the university's academic programs and research interests. The collection includes scholarly books, journals, research papers, and access to leading electronic databases, ensuring seamless access to up-to-date and reliable information.

Study Spaces:

The library provides study spaces for individual study, group discussions, and collaborative work. These spaces are equipped with comfortable seating, desks, and access to power outlets for students to study and work on their projects.

Digital Resources:

The UoL Library subscribes to a wide range of electronic databases, financial tools, statistical analysis platforms, e-journals, and e-books, offering rich and specialized digital content to the academic community. Online access is provided to IEEE Xplore, EBSCO Research Databases, ProQuest Central, as well as academic journals from SAGE and Taylor & Francis. Additionally, specialized legal databases such as HeinOnline and LexisNexis are available.

All resources are accessible both on campus and remotely. Through OpenAthens, users can securely log in and access subscribed content from anywhere in the world. Additionally, the EBSCO Discovery Service (EDS) provides a centralized search platform, allowing users to explore and retrieve materials from across all subscribed databases in a single, unified interface. The library's digital collection is continuously expanding to meet the evolving needs of the university community.

Reference and Research Assistance:

The library staff members are available to help and guidance to users, helping them effectively utilize the available resources. They assist in locating relevant materials, conducting research, and navigating the library's electronic databases. Additionally, they offer guidance on citation styles, information literacy, and fundamental research methodologies.

The library also offers an online booking system, allowing users to schedule one-on-one or group meetings, either virtually or in-person, based on their preferences and needs.

Interlibrary Loan:

In cases where the required resources are not available in the library's collection, interlibrary loan is offered. This allows users to request books from other libraries, expanding the availability of resources. The library collaborates with universities in Cyprus, such as University of Cyprus, Cyprus University of Technology, University of Nicosia, European University Cyprus, Frederick University, and Neapolis University Paphos. Users can also use the library spaces at these institutions for reading, in addition to borrowing books.

Workshops and Training:

The UoL Library regularly organizes workshops and training sessions to enhance users' information literacy skills. These sessions cover various topics, such as effective database searching, research strategies, bibliography management, as well as the use of tools like Mendeley for reference management and Turnitin for plagiarism detection. Participants have the opportunity to learn how to use these tools to strengthen their academic work and improve their research capabilities.

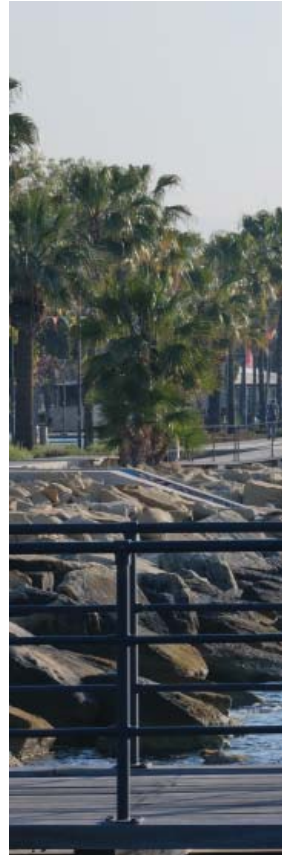
Discover Cyprus / Discover Limassol

The island's easy-to-reach location, the mild Cyprus climate, safe laid-back lifestyle, affordable cost of living, hospitable English-speaking society, and satiating cuisine add to its charm and popularity. Also renowned for its breathtaking natural world, the country is an explorer's paradise, blessed with a glistening cobalt coastline and a rugged green mountainous interior.

A land of exciting contrasts, cosmopolitan cities befriend an ancient heritage spanning over 10 000 years. All this, with world-class higher education, high standard accommodation, advanced infrastructure and services, and countless modern amenities enticing thousands of international students to the island each year.





Discover Limassol

Limassol is located on the sun kissed southern coast of Cyprus. It is the second largest city on the island with a population of over 200k, well known for its outgoing, friendly, and welcoming inhabitants. A modern hub and a melting pot of cultures, this fast-evolving hot-spot is ideal for students looking to study in a vibrant yet laid-back seaside environment.

Globally renowned as a booming business and shipping centre, Limassol blends a fascinating past with a vibrant and dynamic contemporary appeal. Striking skyscrapers reach for the skies beside historic buildings, while luxurious seaside hotels and ancient sites vie for attention by sandy shores. In the city centre, artsy café bars housed in old mansions burst with hip urban style beside smart office buildings housing the headquarters of countless international companies.

Ideal for both study and recreation, Limassol offers the best of both worlds: modern city life and a sun-soaked outdoor lifestyle. The city sprawls across a stunning stretch of fine Mediterranean coastline backed by walking and cycling paths and dotted with countless beaches inviting you to take a refreshing plunge in the warmer months. Nature lovers can also enjoy the best of Cyprus' rural world, with the towering peaks of the Troodos Mountains just a short drive away – a haven for skiers and snowboarders in the coldest months. Quaint wine-producing villages, pretty waterfalls, and fascinating folklore museums add to the charm of the rugged terrain beyond the city.

Must-visit Limassol attractions

There are heaps of sites to see and endless experiences to enjoy in a city where all things cool and contemporary nod to the past every step of the way. Here is all you need to know about some of Limassol's most talked-about attractions.

Molos promenade

The perfect spot to begin or end your day, Limassol's Molos promenade is where the action is around-the-clock. Do like the locals and head here for an invigorating walk right by the water's edge – check out the promenade's handy bicycle hire facilities – or enjoy a heart-pumping skateboarding or rollerblading adventure. When you fancy a break, be sure to take a selfie on one of the area's piers jutting out into the cobalt blue. Or sip on a frothy frappé (Cyprus' famous iced coffee) at one of the buzzing promenade coffee shops. Framed by towering palm trees, the promenade spans a length of approximately one kilometre from the old Limassol port to the western tip of Akti Olympion beach. The area also features a skate park, an outdoor gym, impressive sculptures by local and international artists, and water fountains.



Old town hub

Limassol's old town is laced with a maze of winding roads begging to be explored; the perfect area to spend your free time in laid-back Mediterranean style. By day, the area's colourful street art dazzles the senses, the tables of cool cafes spill out onto the pavements, and independent shops lure the curious shopper. By night, hip bars attract fun-loving crowds and stylish restaurants dish up some of the best food on the island. The area is also packed with interesting sites to see. Start your journey of discovery at the stunning Agia Napa Cathedral, built in the late 19th and early 20th century. Once you have taken in the impressive architecture of this city landmark, make a beeline for the Limassol Agora. The renovated old market hosts fun events and parties throughout the year and is a great spot to eat, drink and hang out with friends.

Limassol Medieval Castle & Cyprus Medieval Museum

A key attraction in the heart of the old town near the old harbour, Limassol Medieval Castle is famed as the spot where Berengaria of Navarre was crowned Queen of England as she wed Richard the Lionheart. Accounts documenting when the castle was first built vary, but some sources indicate that the original castle was erected by Guy de Lusignan in 1193. As the years went by, the castle suffered damages from Cyprus earthquakes and invader assaults and was rebuilt in its current form in 1590. Step inside today to walk around the castle museum filled with ancient treasures documenting the daily life of Cypriots between the 3rd and 18th century A.D.



Limassol Marina & adjacent Old Port

Craving a bite to eat or want to watch the world go by right by the sea? The Limassol Marina is the place to be. Featuring a mix of classy high-end restaurants and affordable chain restaurants and cafes, this Limassol landmark forms a buzzing hub of activity, especially on weekends and national holidays. Stay on as the sun goes down to enjoy the twinkle of lights reflected in the water by luxurious yachts. The adjacent Old Port is also one of Limassol's top attractions. Recently renovated a few years ago, people of all ages congregate here to stroll through the large square and along the pedestrian walkway lined with restaurants and cafes.





Curium (Kourion) Amphitheatre

If there's one ancient site that deserves to be on the top of your bucket list, it simply has to be the Curium Amphitheatre, located 13 km west of Limassol. This historic beauty is perched high on a cliff top overlooking the glistening Mediterranean Sea and a patchwork of land below. Part of an important city-kingdom in antiquity, the amphitheatre was originally built in the 2nd century B.C. but what you will see today actually dates to the Roman period, following restorations undertaken in the 2nd and 3rd century A.D. Its curved auditorium can accommodate 3500 people and it's one of the best theatres to watch an al fresco evening summer performance under starry skies.

Amathus Archaeological Site

Not quite as imposing as the Curium, it's easy to miss the Amathus Archaeological Site, located 11 km east of the Limassol city centre just off the seafront road. But don't let that stop you from visiting. This sacred spot is one of the most important ancient sites in Cyprus. A place where Goddess Aphrodite was once worshipped, mythology has it that Greek hero Theseus left the pregnant Ariadne here to be cared for after a battle with a Minotaur. As you explore the site where myths and legends spring to life, look out for the ancient Agora, the public baths, and the temple of Aphrodite.

Coffee culture

A passion for coffee goes hand in hand with the Cypriot lifestyle. And there are few places on the island where a flourishing coffee culture is more prevalent than the streets of Limassol. The old town is a true coffee-lovers hot spot, lined with just about every type of café imaginable; from old-school traditional style 'kafenía' to trendy third-wave coffee shops serving aromatic artisan blends. If you prefer a relaxing caffeine fix with sea views, head to the nearby Molos promenade or Old Port area.



Eating out

Often celebrated as the gastronomic capital of Cyprus, Limassol is every foodie's dream, with top-rated restaurants around every corner. Enjoy a delicious taste of Cypriot meze, the best of Mediterranean fusion cuisine, and mouth-watering seafood. The city is also home to fine Asian, Middle Eastern, and South American eateries. Casual joints specialising in street food are equally popular with crowds looking for a delicious energy boost before a night out. The old town is packed with casual independent joints making juicy burgers, stone-baked pizzas, tempting tacos, hearty noodles, and more. International fast-food chains and franchises are also easy to find around town, especially by the Limassol Marina and along the Germasoyia coastal strip.

Shopping therapy

Once mostly associated with its high-end boutiques and designer fashion, Limassol has taken on a whole new appeal over the past decade as funky concept stores and independent speciality shops breathe new life into the city. From offbeat old town shops selling artisan jewellery and collectible books to handcrafted bags and wooden eco-friendly sunglasses, they all contribute to Limassol's unique vibe. Anexartisias Street and Makarios Avenue also cater to various tastes and budgets, packed with well-known international fashion brands, sports stores, gift shops, and beauty outlets. For easy shopping under one roof, the city's mall in the western suburb of Zakaki offers a world of choice alongside dining options and exciting entertainment including bowling and a virtual 6D cinema.

Beachside bliss

Whether you love a refreshing mid-day dip or dream of lounging on a sandy shore with a sundowner in hand, there are countless Limassol beaches to choose from. The Blue Flag Dasoudi beach in the heart of Germasoyia is one of the best stretches of sand in town. Located very close to a public bus stop, there are plenty of organised facilities and water sports to enjoy here. A little further afield, Lady's Mile Beach is very popular with the locals – a 5-kilometre stretch with shallow waters, countless amenities, and some hip and happening beach bars. And if you're keen to discover a quieter stretch of coastline, head west of Limassol to the windswept Avdimou Beach. Kick back with a good book or look out for toned kite surfers riding the waves out at sea.

Nightlife fun

Limassol is a lively city that certainly knows how to party. And no matter what kind of music rocks your world, there is bound to be a bar, pub, or club – or even a microbrewery – to suit your individual taste. If you want to mix and mingle with other students and locals throughout the autumn and winter, the old town is the perfect area for casual bar hopping. Head through the bar-lined web of streets that branch off Limassol Castle Square and lead up to University Square and Saripolou Square. As spring approaches, Limassol attracts fun-loving crowds from around the country and beyond as annual carnival celebrations render the entire city a pulsating party zone. Come summer, the fun moves to the seafront where countless lively beach bars transform the seafront area into one big and breezy outdoor extravaganza.



Day trip inspiration

Taking a complete break away from studying and the daily routine is easy in Limassol. Embark on a trip outside the city to discover stone built villages and historic sites dotted across the lower vine-covered slopes of the Troodos Mountains. The villages of Vouni, Koilani, Lofou, and Lania are some of the prettiest in Cyprus and are perfect for a day out. You can even book a night away with friends in a large renovated old village house. Many even feature swimming pools and outdoor barbeque areas. At higher altitudes, the leafy summer resort of Platres beckons, close to three of the island's most beautiful waterfalls: Caledonia, Millomeri, and Chantara. The entire Troodos mountain range is ideal for hikers and thrill seekers, and panoramic views await when you reach the Mount Olympus Observation Point between Prodromos and Troodos Square. From January through to March, head to the Troodos Ski Center for some action on the powdery white slopes.
