Θέμα: Ανανέωση της «Επιτροπής Συμβούλων Υπηρεσιών Συμβουλευτικής Συναλλαγών»  
της Καμπότζης

Αναφορικά με το πιο πάνω θέμα, διαβιβάζεται ενημέρωση η οποία ελήφθη σήμερα, μέσω ηλεκτρονικού ταχυδρομείου, από την Αντιπροσωπεία της ΕΕ η οποία αφορά μήνυμα από το Υπουργείο Οικονομίας και Οικονομικών της χώρας σχετικά με την ανανέωση της «Επιτροπής Συμβούλων Υπηρεσιών Συμβουλευτικής Συναλλαγών» για την περίοδο 2026-2029.

Η εν λόγω επιτροπή, σύμφωνα με τον Επικεφαλής του Τμήματος Συνεργασίας της Αντιπροσωπείας της ΕΕ Bryan Fornari, θα χρησιμεύσει ως ο κύριος μηχανισμός για τη Γενική Υπηρεσία Συμπράξεων Δημόσιου και Ιδιωτικού Τομέα (General Department of Public-Private Partnerships) για την κινητοποίηση συμβούλων (mobilise advisors) για μεγάλα έργα υποδομών και κοινωνικού τομέα κατά τα επόμενα τρία χρόνια.

Ειδικότερα, Bryan Fornari ζητεί όπως η επισυναπτόμενη επιστολή του Υφυπουργού του εν θέματι Υπουργείου και η Αίτηση Εκδήλωσης Ενδιαφέροντος προωθηθεί σε ΚΕΒΕ και άλλους εμπλεκόμενους φορείς κρατών μελών προκειμένου να διευκολυνθεί η συμμετοχή ευρωπαϊκών εταιρειών και συμβουλευτικών εταιρειών στην εν θέματι επιτροπή σημειώνοντας ότι οι ευρωπαϊκές εταιρείες διαθέτουν την τεχνική εμπειρογνώμοσύνη σε βιώσιμες υποδομές που επιδιώκει η Επιτροπή Συμβούλων Υπηρεσιών Συμβουλευτικής Συναλλαγών. Τονίζει, παράλληλα, ότι η διεύρυνση της εμβέλειας ετών Ευρωπαϊκών δικτύων θα συνεισφέρει στη διασφάλισή ότι ο ιδιωτικός τομέας κρατών μελών θα εκπροσωπείται έντονα.

Με βάση τις δημόσια διαθέσιμες πληροφορίες, φαίνεται ότι μόνο μία ευρωπαϊκή εταιρεία έχει επί του παρόντος οριστεί ως ανάδοχος-πλαίσιο που παρέχει υποστήριξη στην κυβέρνηση

σχετικά με έργα Δημόσιου-Ιδιωτικού Τομέα ( <https://ppp.mef.gov.kh/financial-support-mechanisms/panel-of-consulting-firms-idc-panel>).

Η προθεσμία υποβολής είναι ανοιχτή για σαράντα πέντε ημέρες από την ημερομηνία έκδοσης , ήτοι την 30<sup>η</sup> Απριλίου. Ως εκ τούτου, η προθεσμία υποβολής ενδιαφέροντος λήγει στις 15 Ιουνίου και ώρα 5 μ.μ. Καμπότζης , δηλαδή 1μ.μ. ώρα Κύπρου.

Για περισσότερες διευκρινήσεις, αναφέρει ο κ. Fornari, οι ενδιαφερόμενοι μπορούν να επικοινωνήσουν απευθείας με το εμπλεκόμενο Υπουργείου έως και 15 ημέρες πριν τη λήξη της προθεσμίας υποβολής ενδιαφέροντος , καθώς τα στοιχεία επαφής αναγράφονται στο έγγραφο εκδήλωσης ενδιαφέροντος ( πρώτη σελίδα) . This panel will serve as the primary mechanism for the General Department of Public-Private Partnerships to mobilise advisors for major infrastructure and social sector projects over the next three years.

In order to facilitate the participation of European companies and consulting firms, I would appreciate it if you could disseminate the attached letter and Request for Expression of Interest through your respective chambers of commerce, business associations, and other professional networks. European firms possess the technical expertise in sustainable infrastructure that this panel seeks; broadening the outreach within our networks will help ensure that our private sector is strongly represented.

The submission window is open for **forty-five days** from the date of issuance, so this remains time-sensitive.

**Request for Expressions of Interest (REOI)  
Selection of Consulting Firms under Indefinite Delivery Contracts for the Panel  
of Transaction Advisory Services Consultants for PPP Projects**

1. The Government of the Kingdom of Cambodia (GKC) enacted the Law on Public-Private Partnerships (PPP) in 2021 and adopted the Sub-Decree on Standard Operating Procedures for PPP Projects in 2022 under which a Project Development Facility for PPP Projects (PDF) has been established to finance the project preparation and other transaction services of Priority PPP Projects.
2. The General Department of Public-Private Partnerships (GDPPP) of the Ministry of Economy and Finance (MEF), as the management agency for the PDF, intends to renew the Panel of Transaction Advisory Services Consultants under Indefinite Delivery Contract (the "IDC Panel") to have access to a large pool of experts from highly reputable consulting firms. The detailed consultant selection process is provided in **Appendix 1**.
3. The scope of services of the Consultants in the IDC Panel involves the provision of project preparation and transaction advisory services for PPP projects in Cambodia across various economic and social sectors.
4. In this regard, the GDPPP invites eligible national and international consulting firms to submit the Expression of Interest (EOI), using the prescribed template available at **Appendix 3** and provide the information and attachments demonstrating their eligibilities, capabilities and availability of PPP-related experiences and technical expertise, for inclusion in the IDC Panel. The IDC Panel will be retained for a period of three (3) years (2026-2029) from the date of approval of the selection of the Consultants by the MEF. The scope of work is outlined in the Terms of Reference (TOR) as attached hereto as **Appendix 2**.
5. The Consultants selected to be part of the IDC Panel will be retained under an Indefinite Delivery Contract without any commitment on the part of the MEF or the GKC.
6. Completed EOIs shall be submitted by email using the prescribed template in PDF format before the closing date and time at the address given below:
